

Sumitomo Mitsui Trust Bank (Thai) PCL ("SMTBT") organized the ESG activity "Mangrove Planting Activity" on November 19, 2022 at Khlong Khon Mangrove Forest Conservation Center (located 80 km to the west of Bangkok). Planting mangroves will not only curb CO2 emissions but will also provide safe nesting and breeding habitats for many species of wild life both below the water and on land, including fish and birds. The area is also known as home to several groups of monkeys and on that day, we received a grand welcome from them.





While this event was coordinated through the leadership of the national staff of SMTBT and temporarily put on hold due to the Covid-19 pandemic, mangrove planting was a great opportunity for all 54 participants, consisting of both Japanese expats and Thai local staff, to consider the importance of environmental conservation. Through sharing a common experience, this day also served as a valuable team building activity. SMTBT plans to continue working on activities which increase ESG awareness of our staff and contribute to building a more sustainable society.
